

Since its debut in 2012, Dad's Hat Pennsylvania Rye Whiskey has commanded the attention of whiskey lovers the world over. If the recent prestigious honors bestowed upon the Keystone-state-produced spirit are any indication, this pure expression of classic Pennsylvania Rye Whiskey is also building a following among some of the whiskey industry's most respected names.

Announced on December 4th, 2015, Whisky Advocate Magazine named Dad's Hat Pennsylvania Rye Whiskey as its Craft Whiskey of The Year. The Magazine recognizes the world's greatest whiskies and distilleries, and the individuals who make and promote them. Historic Team-Up To Revive Classic Rye



Dad's Hat Rye Whiskey and Del-Val University Join Forces to Re-establish Heirloom Rye

Rosen Rye was once the preferred rye grain for making Pennsylvania's famous rye whiskeys, but as rye whiskey production began to wane, so did the production of Rosen Rye. Since launching the first rye whiskey distillery in Pennsylvania in over 20 years, Dad's Hat Rye went in search of this famous rye grain.

After contacting farmers, state agricultural officials, and universities, we discovered a stash of seeds in a US Department of Agriculture Seed Bank. A chance meeting with Professor John Urbanchuk from Del-Val University in Doylestown, PA during a tour of the distillery led to a collaboration to bring this heirloom grain back to life. The first seeds are already under cultivation and there is a lot more work to be done, but this is a very exciting first step.

Having Rosen Rye grain available again should be an important ingredient for making our rye whiskey even more delicious; but it could also be an important development for Pennsylvania agriculture. The market for domestic rye grain for distilling is growing and this could be a great opportunity for Pennsylvania farmers. Some rye whiskey distillers in Kentucky and Indiana have turned to sourcing their rye from Germany and Sweden, so we want to help our farmers here in the USA get back in the game.
