Pennsylvania – tapping into the Keystone state's
agricultural richness to obtain the highest quality
grain while supporting the local economy.

Our recipe uses only local rye grain, malted
barley and a sweet mash process to deliver a pure
expression of classic Pennsylvania Rye Whiskey.

The result is a very smooth whiskey the way it was
made in its “heyday” – delivering the up-front
spice that rye is known for while finishing
with a full, round mouthfeel.

In the end, it all comes down to one thing –
genuine rye whiskey that would make Dad
“Pennsylvania proud.”

The flavor coats the tongue in layers of pepper and cinnamon spice, green apple, fig and cocoa powder with a long, smooth and lingering finish. This rye really delivers.

VERMOUTH FINISH**

Finish aged in used sweet vermouth casks from Quady Winery. The Pennsylvania-style base rye yields a distinctive spicy malt character which melds nicely with the vermouth finish in layers of raisin, figs, dates and caramel. Round, complex, demanding to be savored.

Finish aged in used wine casks from Quady Winery. Brilliant bronze color. Delicate, fruity aromas of raisin cake, caramel buttercream, suede and pepper. Silky, lively, fruity body and a warming, involved, toasted fruitcake and cedar leads to an exotically spiced finish.
